

Before Starting the Project Listings for the CoC Priority Listing

The FY2015 CoC Consolidated Application requires 2 submissions. Both this Project Priority Listing AND the CoC Consolidated Application MUST be submitted.

The FY 2015 CoC Priority Listing contains the following forms:

Things to Remember

- The Priority Listing ranks the projects in order of priority all new project applications created through Reallocation and the Permanent Housing Bonus as well as renewal project applications and identifies any project applications rejected by the CoC.
- Collaborative Applicants are strongly encouraged to list all project applications on the FY2015 CoC Ranking Tool located on the HUD Exchange to ensure a ranking number is used only once. The FY 2015 CoC Ranking Tool will assist the Collaborative Applicant during the ranking process among the four Project Listings.
- Any project applications rejected by the Collaborative Applicant must select the reason for rejection.
- Collaborative Applicants should notify all project applicants no later than 15 days before the application deadline regarding whether their project applications will be included as part of the CoC Priority Listing submission.

The grantee, Catholic Charities and the two sub-recipients (Barrett Foundation and Albuquerque Health Care for the Homeless), voluntarily decided to reallocate these TH funds to a new Rapid Rehousing project and Coordinated Assessment Project in order to better serve homeless individuals and families. Catholic Charities and SAFE House are part of the new RRH grant. These two organizations voluntarily agreed to have the City of Albuquerque be the applicant for this new RRH project, with their organizations as sub-recipients. The other sub-recipient decided to reallocate their portion of the TH funds to a new Coordinated Assessment SSO project. The City made this decision after consulting with and receiving support from the three sub-recipients who will be impacted. The City is applying for a new RRH project that will involve the same three sub-recipients. This decision was approved by the Albuquerque CoC Independent Review Committee (IRC) as the IRC felt that the recipient and sub-recipients have the experience and capacity to carry out the new project.

The Albuquerque CoC Independent Review Committee (IRC) met on 10/15/15 to evaluate and rank all renewal projects, using written evaluation criteria that had been established by the IRC earlier in the year. At this meeting the IRC decided to reduce funding for this project because it had underspent its FY12 grant by about \$27,000, its FY13 grant by about \$52,000 and was on track to underspend its FY14 grant as well. The project was notified in writing of this decision and informed of the CoC's written appeals process. The applicant choose not to appeal.
